



Green Light Week!

During Tuesday, Oct. 6th - Monday, Oct. 12th, residents can (without needing to isolate upon return):

- Visit safely with their family in their family's home (visitation form required and visiting outdoors is preferred)
- Go out to restaurants, retail shops, grocery stores, hair salons, etc. (form not required)

Outside guests are still not permitted to visit with residents inside of the community.

Hospital/ER/Urgent Care visits and any overnight travel would require a 14 day-isolation upon return to the community.

****Please note! COVID data is on the rise. Green Light weeks occur if the data stays below 5% and currently, the average positivity rate is 4.32%. Please be a safe neighbor and follow all guidelines to stay healthy!****

IMPORTANT: Residents who visit with family members and do not schedule those visits or who visit during a RED LIGHT week must self-isolate for fourteen days. Questions?
