

Day Visits to Family's Homes

For week of Monday, Feb. 22nd – Feb. 28th



Green Light – Day visits are permitted this week!

Infection Control Protocols:

What do the GREEN LIGHT and RED LIGHT signals mean?

A Green Light indicates scheduled visits to family homes MAY take place that week.

A Red Light indicates that schedule visits MAY NOT take place that week and must be postponed in order for the resident to avoid fourteen-day social isolation.

What protocols must be followed on visits to family members' homes?

To be safe and to reduce the opportunity for infection, always follow these common sense rules:

1. Outdoor visits are encouraged and provide for a safer & healthier visit; however, if factors such as the weather do not permit an outdoor visit, indoor gatherings are allowed.
2. Everyone wear face masks.
3. Practice good hand-washing techniques before and after each visit.
4. Limit the number of people to assure social distancing of at least six feet between each person.
5. These visits are one day visits only, not extended visits lasting multiple days/overnight.
