New restrictions while positivity is over 10%: (9/10/21) UNIVERSAL EYE PROTECTION- Unvaccinated workers need to wear face shields at all times for all resident care; TESTING- unvaccinated staff and residents (who have left and returned) need to bump up to TWICE a week PCR and continue with daily POC; ACTIVITIES/ MEALS- if vaccination rate of residents is below 70%, unvaccinated residents must be excluded, wear masks when outside of apartments, socially distance, no food and drink unless outdoors. ; VISITS- if vaccination rate of residents is below 70%, limit visits to unvaccinated residents to compassion care only

HOW TO USE DATA: POSITIVITY RATE: SN & AL Routine testing - use positivity rate to determine the frequency of routine testing; allowance for communal dining and activities. For SN & AL, Indoor visits with other restrictions allowed for unvaccinated residents if positivity rate lower than 10%. Universal eye protection needed if >10%. CASES PER 100,000. LEVEL: State determined level of COVID-19 activity with associated restrictions, per CDPHE website.
